# Women and Girls Are the Greatest Victims.



## **Increased risk of morbidity**

A single pot can weight 5lbs, full it can weigh up to 40. Carrying this for miles leaves women with physical strain and injuries

## **Vulnerable to attack**

Women risk physical and sexual abuses' while traveling long distances alone

## **Time lost**

Women and girls in Tharparkar spend an average of 4-6 hours in water collection each day

# Creating Sustainable Solutions.



Water flows at the simple tug of the handle



Solar power runs a pump over 100ft underground, allowing water to reach the surface in even the arid of regions



The plant is electricity independent, leaving villagers to manage this long term on their own without additional costs

In partnership with Idara Al Khair Welfare, Thaakat has launched over 70 solar powered water plants in the drought stricken regions of Interior Sindh, Pakistan
